

# CHARACTER BULLETIN BOARDS

## RESPECT

Appropriate for Every Age Group

**Build this bulletin board gradually while teaching a unit on respect.**

**For adults and older teens, omit the pictures or use age-appropriate photographs instead, basing selection on accuracy of illustration.**

- Begin at the left and add to the bulletin board as you cover different aspects of respect.
- Generate excitement and anticipation from Day #1 by having on your board the word “RESPECT” and all of your blank gray label holders.
- Place extra blank gray label holders to the right of those shown to allow for extension of the categories shown.
- At the beginning of your study, stress the fact that **respect** must come from the **heart**. Add the word “heart” to your first blank label. Use yarn or a strip of paper to connect the two.
- Add an age-appropriate picture of boy and girl, connecting them to the heart.
- Beneath the picture of boy and girl, add the words to the labels as you teach how the body affects the exercise of respect to others.
- Repeat the process with each element as you progress through your study.
- Use Page 3 for REINFORCEMENT and EVALUATION by having students fill in the labels. If you added labels in your study, be sure students remember to add them as a write-in activity.
